The Department of Chemical Engineering, ANITS, arranged an expert lecture on “**Indian Fertilizer Scenario – PROM Technology**” by Dr. D. M. R. Sekhar, Director, CEEC International Ltd. Australia, on 30th of August, 2017. The speaker shared information of the revolutionary Phosphate Rich Organic Manure (PROM) Technology that reduces the phosphorous fixation by soil and increases the amount of available phosphate nutrient for plant intake. He also emphasized the necessity of budding chemical engineers to diversify their fields of study so that they get knowledge of how to utilize different branches of engineering and sciences for the betterment of technologies.
